
Guidance Note for Course Assessments

Introduction

SEATS AI courses are designed to enhance the skills and knowledge of employers and employees in the field of Artificial Intelligence (AI). The courses are City & Guilds Assured and certificated, meeting the high standard of learning and assessment. The final assessment, a multiple-choice test, is intended to validate the learner's understanding of the course content. Below is guidance on the conditions under which the assessment should be taken to maintain the integrity and quality of the certification.

Assessment Environment

Recommended Conditions

- The assessment should be taken in a secure and quiet environment. This ensures that you can concentrate fully on the test without interruptions.
- Use a reliable PC or laptop to take the test. While mobile devices are compatible, a larger screen is recommended for better visibility and ease of use.
- A stable and secure internet connection is crucial to avoid any disruptions during the test.

Assessment Integrity

Fair Practice

- The assessment is designed to gauge your individual understanding of AI concepts and applications. Collaboration with others or using unauthorised resources during the test is strictly discouraged.
- Learners are permitted up to two attempts to pass the test. Each attempt should be taken seriously, as this is a key component of earning the City & Guilds certification.
- The SEATS AI courses are designed to be naturally adaptive, reflecting the flexible nature of AI learning. Therefore, the test conditions are intended to adapt to different learning environments while ensuring fairness and integrity.
